2025 is going to be an exciting year for Nambour Community Foundation, it's our 9th year of community giving, and to date since launching the Foundation in 2016, we have donated more than \$300,000 to eligible community organisations in Nambour and surrounding region.

Becoming a Community Partner is special, as it means you can fund a local grant, and know that your donated funds will be allocated during our annual grants round to projects that directly benefit the local community.

One of the best things about giving to the Nambour Community Foundation, is that none of these donated dollars go towards Administration fees. Our Board of Directors are all local Sunshine Coast professionals who donate their time to Foundation operations.

The annual grants round opens annually on 1 June, and closes on 31 July - you can find out more about the grants application process on our website: ncf.org.au

Each year between 40-60 local community groups apply for cash grants between \$1000-\$10,000, our grants committee then review all of the grants to ensure they meet the eligibility requirements and review their individual merits.

In this brochure, you will find more information about some of the groups we have funded, and what becoming a Community Partner means for your organisation, and steps on how to get involved.

WHO WE ARE

Sundale Community Foundation was established in 2015 by Sundale Ltd with the aim of extending the charitable influence of Sundale through financial grants for worthy projects in Nambour and its environs.

\$1 million was gifted by Sundale Ltd to kick start the Community Foundation, and thanks to the Sundale Community Foundation Board of Volunteers, that money has been invested and earnings from those funds are distributed to community grants each year.

Since our first awards ceremony in 2017, we have issued \$327,214 to 79 not-for-profits, charities and groups in the local community.

Applications for the 2024 Sundale Community Foundation grants round for grants between \$1,000-\$10,000 will open on June 31 2024.
